POPULAR SUZUKI 115 HORSEPOWER FOUR-STROKE OUTBOARD NOW AVAILABLE WITH COUNTER ROTATION FOR TWIN ENGINE INSTALLATIONS

Over the past several years, Suzuki's DF115 4-stroke outboard motor has proven to be a popular choice for owners of a wide variety of boats. Now, with the introduction of a counter rotation 25-inch shaft model, the DF115's appeal has been broadened to include boats with twin engine installations.

"Twin engines are popular on power cats, as well as offshore and inshore fishing boats. Now, boaters can get the benefits of counter rotation all the way down to our 115," says Larry Vandiver, director of marketing for Suzuki Marine. "This opens up a whole new class of smaller cats, center consoles and even skiffs, that can take advantage of the performance and handling characteristics of twin 4-stroke outboards."

Suzuki's DF115 features a four-cylinder 1950cc powerhead with dual overhead cams and digital sequential multi-port fuel injection. A long track tuned intake manifold increases intake air velocity for more power, torque and quieter operation. The engine's center of gravity is shifted forward, thanks to an innovative offset drive shaft, providing not only better balance on the transom, but a smaller profile. With a 2.59:1 gear ratio, the DF115 can swing a bigger prop to provide improved hole shot and faster speed at Wide Open Throttle.

Like all Suzuki fuel-injected 4-stroke outboards, the DF115 meets 2006 federal emissions standards and qualifies for the California Air Resources Board (CARB) 3-Star Ultra-Low Emissions sticker. The DF115 is backed by Suzuki's standard comprehensive three-year limited warranty that covers all key engine components for the entire three years. For more peace of mind, an optional three-year Suzuki Extended Protection Plan is also available, offering boaters six years of protection.
